**ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ORDINANCE 2008-01**

**ATV ROUTES AMENDED**

The Town Board of the Town of Mercer do ordain as follows:

1. That the following named roads in the Town of Mercer shall be designated as all-terrain vehicle **Routes**:
  - a. The Iron Horse Trail (former Chicago Northwestern Railway right-of-way grade that is under the control of the Town of Mercer) from the North town line of the Town of Mercer south to the intersection of Lakeview Avenue; also from the Mercer Historical Society Train Station south to Chuck's Bar.
  - b. Lakeview Ave, East of Railroad Street to Library Street; thence East on Library Street to Lakeshore Drive to the right-of-way through Carow Park, including all portions of Lakeshore Drive previously referred to as Ball Street.
  - c. The right-of-way through Carow Park and past County Trunk Highway H along the North side to Horners Drive.
  - d. Horners Drive North to the open field.
  - e. Cramer Lake Road in its entirety from Bambiland Road to the North Town Line.
  - f. Wallace Road to County Trunk Highway FF in its entirety
  - g. Vaughn Street from the railroad right-of-way grade to the alley on the West side of S Highway 51
  - h. The alley located immediately West of US Highway 51 running North and South from Vaughn Street to alley running East-West by Anchor Inn
  - i. Beachway Drive and Mercer Lake Circle South
  - j. Arrowhead Drive, Rice Lake Road and Great Northern Trails Road
  - k. Murray's Landing Road
  - l. West Fisher Lake Road from Fisher Lake Road North to North Mercer Town Line
  - m. Railroad Grade Road from Beaver Lodge Circle to Beaver Lake
  - n. Both sides of the shoulder of County Highway H North of the driveway at Fire Number 5880N to Cramer Lake Road
  - o. Beaver Road, Beaver Lodge Road, Lake of the Falls Road, Sopko Road, and West Echo Lake Road
  - p. Fierick Road and Well Number 2 Road
  - q. Hiawatha Road, from its intersection with Turtle Flambeau Dam Road to its end, being .40 miles in length
  - r. Downey Road, from its intersection with Turtle Flambeau Dam Road to its end, being .34 miles in length
  - s. O'Meara's Road, from its intersection with County FF to its end, being 1.17 miles in length
  - t. O'Meara's Road South, from its intersection with O'Meara's Road to its end, being .27 miles in length
  - u. Rusk Road, from its intersection with O'Meara's to its end, being .05 miles in length
  - v. Swamp Creek Road and Lake Six Road from County FF to the Carey Town Line, being 13.49 miles in length

- w. Moose Lake Road, from US Highway 51 to its intersection with Swamp Creek Road, being 6.77 miles in length
- x. Kaiser Road, from its intersection with Moose Lake Road to the Carey Town Line, being 1.33 miles in length
- y. Moose Lake Access Road, from its intersection with Kaiser Road to its end, being .80 miles in length
- z. Chippewa Lane, from its intersection with Swamp Creek Road to the Knight Town Line, being .22 miles in length
- aa. Turtle Flambeau Dam Road, from its intersection with County FF to the Sherman Town Line, being 2.35 miles in length
- bb. Flambeau Trail Road, from its intersection with Hiawatha Road to its end, being .43 miles in length
- cc. Redwood Road, from its intersection with Turtle Flambeau Dam Road to its end, being .17 miles in length
- dd. Shady Rest Road, from its intersection with Turtle Flambeau Dam Road to its end, being .17 miles in length
- ee. Koshak Road, from its intersection with Turtle Flambeau Dam Road to its end, being .34 miles in length
- ff. State House Circle
- gg. Three Ten Road
- hh. Poplar Drive
- ii. Margaret Street
- jj. Sheels Road
- kk. Mercer Public Park (Carow Park), excluding the beach area, playground area, baseball fields, tennis courts and basketball courts. Speed specific to this area shall be five (5) miles per hour
- ll. Beaver Lodge Circle from County Highway J to Railroad Grade Road
- mm. Fisher Lake Road from Shays Mill Road to Beaver Lodge Circle
- nn. Fisher Lake Road from Beaver Lodge Circle to Fisher Lake Road West; Fisher Lake Road West from Fisher Lake Road to Cegan Road.
- oo. Beaver Lodge Circle from Railroad Grade Road to Fisher Lake Road
- pp. Shays Mill Road from Fisher Lake Road
- qq. Gade Road from US Highway 51 to Fire Number 5431N
- rr. Martha Lake Road
- ss. Mercer Lake Circle North and Stafford Point Road
- tt. Robin Drive
- uu. Weber Road
- vv. Shoulder of County Road FF from O'Mearas Road to Swamp Creek Road
- ww. Whispering Pines Road
- xx. Pierpont Drive, Lake Tahoe Drive and Golf Course Drive
- yy. County Road J from US Highway 51 to the Railroad Grade
- zz. Black Lake Road, and Musky Point Road from intersection with Black Lake Road to turn-around.
- aaa. Garnet Street from Fire Number 2577W East to US Highway 51 and back.
- bbb. Ball Street Landing from Lakeshore Drive to Grand Portage Lake.
- ccc. Martha Lake Rd

- ddd. Lakeview Avenue from US Highway 51 to Margaret Street
- eee. East Echo Lake Road from 5637N to County Road J
- fff. Country Lane

2. All- terrain vehicles must obey all traffic regulations.
3. All-terrain vehicles travel at their own risk.
4. The speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour on all Town of Mercer all-terrain vehicle routes, roads and streets.
5. Closings: ATV routes on **graveled** Mercer Town Roads will be closed when the Iron County ATV routes are closed.
6. Posting: The above routes shall be designated as Iron County ATV routes and appropriate signs marking said routes as well as controlling traffic and speed limits upon such routes **may** be erected by a designee of the Town of Mercer. If a designee is so appointed, said designee shall be responsible for and is hereby the designated agency for erecting the traffic control and route signs upon such designated routes as herein provided and shall maintain such signs as appropriate. Said designee shall further be required to indemnify the Town of Mercer and shall be solely liable for the proper placement, sufficiency and maintenance of the above referenced traffic control signs and shall bear sole and exclusive responsibility for the lack or proper maintenance thereof.
7. The Iron County Sheriff's Department and the Department of Natural Resources are hereby designated as the law enforcement agencies responsible for enforcing the provisions of this ordinance. The penalty for violating any of the provision of his Ordinance shall be a forfeiture of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00 for each offence.
8. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law and shall repeal and replace all previous all-terrain vehicle ordinances heretofore enacted by the Town of Mercer.
9. Liability: The Town of Mercer does not assume any liability for the use of an ATV in the area described above.
