1. Order of business of the Special Board of Supervisors Meeting
 - a. Mike called the special meeting to order
 - b. Pledge of allegiance
 - c. Roll call: Present were Supervisors Christan Brandt, Rick Boes, Scot Lundquist, Chairman Mike Lambert, Attorney Fritz Schellgell, Treasurer Becky Bettin, Road Foreman Jake Saarnio and Clerk Debbie Hohner.
 - d. The Clerk acknowledged that the meeting was properly posted
2. Discussion and possible action:
 - a. If going to fill the open Supervisor seat and process of selection: The open position will be posted in the paper and will be selected at the December 11th meeting
 - b. Replacement of garage doors at the garage: Scot made a motion, seconded by Christan to retract his prior approval of the LaForce Door Contract. Carried. Rick made a motion, seconded by Scot to go with the new contract with LaForce Doors in the amount of \$17,867.43 for outside and inside doors for the garage. Carried
 - c. Bids for loader: Scot rescinded his prior meeting motion for least of the loader in the amount of 27,267.23/year, seconded by Christan. Carried Rick made a motion to go with the loader lease in the amount of 44,781.64/year, seconded by Scot. Carried
3. Mike discussed that the boiler in the garage has died and there is not heat, other than the portable heaters that have been purchased. Klopatek is hoping to fix it but it looks as though it might need to be replaced. Fritz will contact the WTA to see if this fits into emergency.
